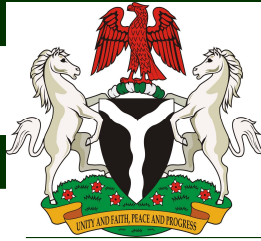

Letter to the General Public

Re: **Nigeria Conversation Holding in Berlin**

We the concerned Nigerians in Germany want to draw the attention of Nigerians to the letter with reference No.: *NBK/IMM/NEB/7/VII*, written by Ambassador Patrick Okoye (see the second attached document).

In relation to the letter, we are concerned about its contents and intention as noted below:

1. the letter has no agenda
2. no time schedule
3. no identification of participants
4. the invitation was directed to a selected group (the non-active Nigerian Community in Germany whose tenure has expired and has outlived its usefulness).

However, the Concerned Nigerians are not only perturbed by the manner at which the invitation was sent, but also with the way in which the Nigerian Embassy and the so called Nigerian Community which has lost its credibility in Germany, have been collaborating in running down the affairs and aspiration of Nigerians in Germany.

Further, Concerned Nigerians found very irritating the failure of Nigerian embassy and the Nigerian community, to understand the distinction between a constructive criticism and the destructive criticism. Critics are progressive people who do not seek self-glory.

The Concerned Nigerians hereby call on all patriotic Nigerians to boycott the meeting. It is unfortunate that the good intentions of the Nigeria Conversation have been rubbished by the Nigeria Embassy and the collaborators.

We advised that in future, the embassy should be more organised and out reaching when it comes to an important issue that involves our national interest.
